Greetings from the Sternberg Museum of Natural History!

Thank you for registering! Below you will find some pertinent information about your child's attendance of our camp program. **Camp starts at 9:00am and ends at 3:00pm.**

1. You will need to sign your son or daughter in upon arrival, and sign them out upon departure. We ask that you also tell us who will be picking your child up at the end of the day (3:00pm). This person will need to have photo ID confirming they are the designated person picking up your child. If the same person is picking up and dropping off your child, please still bring photo ID, as you may not interact with the same camp staff member in the afternoon as you did in the morning.

2. Things to bring:

- a. Sunscreen: We try to do all of our outdoor activities in the morning before it gets too hot outside. Your child should arrive with sunscreen already applied, and with a small bottle in case they need to apply more.
- b. <u>Lunch.</u> (We will provide snacks throughout the day.)
- c. Water bottle that is easy to carry, easily opens, and securely closes.
- d. Secure, close-toed shoes.
- e. Sunglasses and/or a brimmed hat.
- f. Any necessary medications.
- g. Cash if they would like to purchase anything in the gift store.

3. Things not to bring:

- a. Toys of any kind.
- b. Electronic devices such as MP3 players, iPads, or handheld videogame devices.
- c. Knives, or weapons of any sort.
- 4. Smartphone devices are allowed so long as they are kept put away during the camp. If a student has a smartphone device and persists in using it during the camp despite reminders to keep it put away, it will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day. We encourage you to call the Museum office (785-628-5516) if you need to get a message to your child.

If a student does bring one of the banned items listed, it will be collected by staff and returned to the parent/guardian picking up the student at the end of the day.
